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5. GENERALLY

- A. Holiday contacts shall take precedence over regular and school vacation contacts. Special day contacts shall take precedence over regular periods and holiday times for either parent.
- B. During any visitation or custodial period, the parent will be expected to spend as much time as possible with the child/ren.
- C. Each parent shall avoid the scheduling or arranging of activities for the child which are likely to conflict with any visitation or period of custody allocated to the other parent.
- D. Each parent will give the other parent **24 hours** notice in the event he/she is unable to exercise visitation.
- E. The custodial parent will give the non-custodial parent as much notice as is practicable in the event that a child is unable to participate in visitation because of illness.
- F. If the non-custodial parent fails to arrive at the appointed time, the custodial parent need wait only _____ minutes before considering the visitation to have been canceled.
- G. The child/ren is/are to be: picked up by the receiving party at the other 's residen curbside

- H. The child/ren shall be exchanged for visitation at _____
- I. Transportation for visitation shall be arranged by mutual agreement of the parents.
- J. The parents shall stay in their vehicles at the time of the exchanges of the minor child/ren.
- K. The parents shall not disturb the peace in any way at the exchange of the minor child/ren.
- L. Father/ Mother / Both parents shall not bring any third parties to the exchange of the minor child/ren.
- M. Limited to emergency situations, each parent shall be authorized to take any and all actions necessary to protect the health and welfare of the child/ren, including, but not limited to consent to EMERGENCY surgical procedures or treatment. The parent authorizing such emergency treatment shall notify the other parent as soon as possible of such emergency situation and of all procedures or treatment administered to the child/ren.
- N. Each parent shall notify the other of the name and address of each health practitioner who examines or treats the minor child/ren, such notification to be made within 3 days of the commencement of the first such treatment or examination.
- O. Each parent shall keep the other advised at all times of his/her current residence/ mailing address, telephone/ message numbers (home and work) the child/ren's school and the location of any place where the child/ren will be spending any extended period of time of four days or more. Neither parent shall use such information for the purpose of harassing or annoying the other in any way, and each shall be specifically restrained and enjoined from disturbing the other's peace or invading the other's privacy by any means whatsoever.
- P. Each parent shall have open telephonic access to the minor child/ren at reasonable times and for reasonable durations, without any third party interfering or eavesdropping.
- Q. Each parent shall have as much additional time with the minor child/ren as can be agreed upon by the parents.
- R. Each parent shall have access to the child/ren's school, medical and dental records.
- S. Each parent shall be designated as a person the child/ren's school is to contact in the event of an emergency; *changes in schools shall be by mutual agreement in advance if parents share legal custody.*
- T. The children shall not be left alone without age appropriate supervision.
- U. The parents shall communicate directly with each other in matters concerning the minor children and shall not use the children as messengers between them.
- V. The minor child/ren shall not be exposed to second hand smoke while in the presence of either parent.
- W. Either parent shall have the first option to provide child care for the minor child/ren
 While the other parent is at work. While the other parent is away overnight
- X. No party shall be intoxicated or under the influence of illegal substances while caretaking the minor children.

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- Y. To help settle custody disputes in the future, the parents agree to / shall participate in at least three custody conflict resolution sessions with a mutually agreed upon mediator/counselor prior to returning to mediation.
- Z. No one shall discuss custody and court related issues around the child unless directed to do so by the court.

6. RESTRAINTS ON CONDUCT

- A. Each parent is enjoined and restrained from making any negative or disparaging remark about the other parent or allowing any third party to do so in the presence of the minor child/ren.
- B. Both parents (agree not to) (are ordered not to) **PERMANENTLY** remove the minor child/ren from:
