STANDING ORDER

Effective July 20, 2022, the per diem fees for reporting testimony and proceedings in the Superior Court in and for the County of Tehama by Official Court Reporters Pro Tempore is established in the sum of \$700.00 for a full day and \$450.00 for a half day. Hours worked over a four-hour period will be paid at the full day rate.

In addition to a per diem, Official Court Reporters Pro Tempore shall receive fees for transcriptions incident to reporting services provided for in Article 9, commencing with Section 69940 of the California Government Code. However, they are not entitled to Court benefits such as retirement, vacation, sick leave and group insurance.


A cancellation fee, not to exceed the half-day or full-day compensation rates included in this order, may be paid if the court entered into an agreement with a court reporter more than 24 hours or one business day in advance of the assignment, and either the following occurs:

- The court cancels the assignment with less than 24-hour notice.
- The court cancels the assignment that begins on the first business day of the workweek without one business days' notice.

This standing order shall expire on December 31, 2024.
