8 announced on July 28, 2021, by California Department of Public Health (CDPH), **IT IS**

11 **ORDER**

12 **A.** Entry Requirements Effective August 2, 2021

13 1. Access to the courthouse remains restricted as previously ordered but as modified herein, to
14 be effective as follows:

15 No individual shall enter the courthouse if they have tested positive for
16 COVID-19 within the last 10 days, or if they have been ordered by Public
17 Health to isolate, or if they have had sustained contact for 15 minutes or more
18 with someone described above, or if the individual has a fever of 100.4 or
19 higher, or if the individual has COVID-19 symptoms.

20 Any individual entering the courthouse must be in compliance with these
21 conditions to gain entry into the courthouse. Any individual not in compliance
22 shall call the Tehama Superior Court at (530) 527-3563.

23 **B.** Mandatory Masks


24 Masks or facial coverings are required while inside Tehama County Superior Court facilities,
25 regardless of vaccination status. This will remain in place at this time for all individuals entering
26 the Tehama Superior Court including court users, court staff, judicial officers, inmates,
27 jurors/prospective jurors, and counsel. The mask requirement is to ensure workplace and
28 courthouse safety in a manner that maintains efficient and consistent court operations and
 complies with the current Cal OSHA regulations.
